Year 2004 has been an eventful year for SGDF. It has seen the debut of the Singapore Nationals Championships series, international competitions and many SGDF performances. Especially memorable was the 1st Singapore Nationals held at Hougang Community Club, where DanceSport was brought closer to the grassroots organisations. SGDF's Grand Slam Latin Championships, held jointly with the 17th Lion City DanceSport Championships, was also an outstanding success in 2004.

The SGDF Committee worked hard to promote DanceSport in Singapore, especially amongst the young. SGDF stepped up its promotional activities to raise DanceSport awareness at the tertiary institutions. One of these activities was the promotion of Dance-Sport at Singapore Management University's (SMU) Sports Fiesta. Our DanceSport booth attracted a lot interest from the students and our dance show, performed by our affiliate dance club, Ngee Ann DanceSport Club, received an overwhelming response from everyone at the campus. SGDF was invited to do a DanceSport Workshop in SMU. Encouraged by the response, we continued to cultivate the DanceSport Club in SMU.

SGDF has in the past year has also enlarged our base pool of licensed Adjudicators by sending them to attend overseas dancesport congresses. We are proud to present an additional 4 International Adjudicators (Grade A) and 2 National Adjudicators. Congratulations to Mr. Robert Ong, Ms Sabrina Sim, Mr. Michael Lim, Ms Hwa Mee Thoo, Mr. Melvin Tan & Ms Sharon Tan for the completion of the IDSF Adjudicators' Congress.

Our Adjudicators have since been selected by the IDSF to judge at several International Dancesport Championships. Ms Sabrina Sim was invited to adjudicate in the 2004 Asian DanceSport Championships (Korea); and Mr Robert Ong adjudicated in the 2004 Malaysian Nationals. We are also very proud that Mr Robert Ong was nominated by IDSF to adjudicate in the IDSF World Junior II Latin Championships (Latvia), and the Baltic International DanceSport Championships. Indeed, this adds another milestone to the SGDF's accolade.

IDSF World Junior II Latin Championships Riga, Latvia, 18 December 2004

When we knew that we had to represent Singapore to participate in the World Junior II event in Riga, Latvia in December, we were very apprehensive as we had only about 4-5 months to prepare for this event. We were worried as to how we had to manage school activities, and yet find time to attend dance lessons and practice.



However, with the strong support from both our parents and encouragement from our national coaches, we soon found ourselves embarking on this challenge. We trained very hard and were practicing 4 to 5 times a week. Initially, we found it toughgoing but we were able to persevere with the enduring support, motivation and positive assurance from our parents.



To assess our readiness for the world event, we participated in IDSF Junior Open event in Shanghai and came in 4th. This achievement gave us a great boost in our confidence in the world stage.

Come 18 December 2004, with much nervousness and excitement

we competed in the World Junior II Latin Championship with a total strength of 64 couples. We were duly prepared and determined to do our very best on the floor. Our tension showed during the first round with the intense competition but we soon overcame the anxiety. We were then able to execute our dance moves better and showed more confidence during next round and were pleased to finish off with a 45th placing at this event.

This experience has indeed taught us much. We witnessed discipline, resilience and determination exuded from the competitors. All the competitors showed their prowess in their dancing and we have learnt that we should not be complacent and to keep finding ways to improve our own skills in the international arena. With the exposure we had, and understanding of world standards, we endeavour to do better in the future and never fear tough competition as it only motivated us to be better.
