3rd Singapore Nationals 2005



Dear Readers,

The 1st quarter has been quite eventful in the Singapore DanceSport calendar. On the March 12, we hosted our 3rd Singapore Nationals to an overwhelming crowd at the Ngee Ann Convention Center. This is the first time we we held Nationals in the premises of a tertiary Institute. The Convention Center was an ideal location as it could accommodate more than 500 spectators.

Our venue proved to be an excellent choice as we were able to attract many of the students for the event. Once again, the Singapore Nationals was a sold out event providing good food and fantastic dance competitions.

The Nationals started promptly with an opening performance by the Ngee Ann DanceSport Formation Team, and top NPDS DanceSport Athletes, Julian Soon & Iris Tan.



There are many firsts in the 3rd Singapore Nationals. This is the first time that we organized a Tertiary Closed Event where we have Nanyang Technology University and Ngee Ann Polytechnic in competition. This inter-tertiary event received very good support as we were able to garner 23 couple teams to participate. Many of the competitors were beginners and indeed, this was a good start to the development of DanceSport in the tertiary arena.

This was also the first time that the Singapore Nationals Series held competitions in the Grade A events. The Grade A Standard and the Grade A Latin events were awe-inspiring as they drew an astounding enthusiasm and cheers from the spectators in the finals.

By the end of the evening, new stars and champions were born. The Grade A Standard was won by Vasily Chuply & Priscilla Kwa; and in the Grade A Latin, Melvin Tan & Sharon Tan once again, took the National Champions title.

their instructors, Melvin Tan and Sharon Tan (the reigning Latin Grade A National Champions).

NPDS had 10 couples competing in the first time ever Tertiary-closed 1-dance event. This was a popular event, attracting couples from Ngee Ann Polytechnic and Nanyang Technological University to compete on the same dance floor in this beginner's event. In this category, 4 out of 6 the finalist couples were from NPDS as they clinched the 1st Runner-up, 4th, 5th and 6th positions.

In the national-ranked category, Li JinJin (President of NP DanceSport) was placed Champion in Latin Grade E (Cha Cha) and presently ranked 2nd in Latin Grade E National chart. Iris Tan, a 1st year Banking and Financial Services student, was also placed Champion and 2nd Runner-up for Latin Grade C and Grade A respectively. She is currently ranked 1st on the Latin Grade C National chart.

Upcoming next, is the 9th Malaysia Open 2005 DanceSport Championships on 1 May 2005. The NPDS is looking forward to this competition in KL, organised by a member of the Malaysian DanceSport Berhad (IDSF member in Malaysia). The competitors will be competing in both events of Beginners Cha Cha Cha and Beginners Jive. We wish everyone the very best of luck!

March 12th was the 3rd SGDF Nationals held at Ngee Ann Polytechnic. It was also the competitive debut for NTU's 14 couples participating in the Latin Tertiary Closed (Cha Cha Cha) category. A totally new experience for many for the competing couples, as none of them had prior public performance exposure before. Nevertheless, our couples braved the new challenges and put up excellent showing on the competition floor.

The heats and qualifying rounds were down to the luck of the draw, as songs of varying difficulty levels were played at every single dance. Inexperience showed through despite weeks of practice as more difficult songs stumbled several couples.

Finally, dancers from NTU DanceSport Academy proved their true mettle to clinch the Champion spot and the 2nd runner up spot despite having only 2 couples in the final 6.
